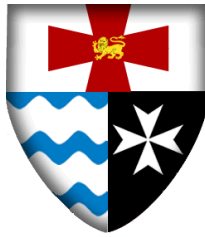

Order of Proceedings

1. By 4.10 pm all Knights will assemble and be seated in the Temple.
2. At 4.15 pm the Temple Delegation will enter.
3. At 4.20 pm, E. Kt. Antony Fabian Legge, Provincial Sub-Prior, accompanied by the Provincial Prelate and Officers of the Octagonal and Pentagonal Tables will enter in procession.
4. At 4.25 pm the Rt. E. Kt. David James Thompson, Provincial Prior, accompanied by certain Great Officers will enter in procession.
5. A Chapter of Provincial Priory of Malta will be opened by the Provincial Sub-Prior.
6. The minutes of the meeting held on Jan 2023 having been approved, will be submitted for confirmation.
7. Certain candidates will be elected as Knights of Malta and admitted as Knights of St. Paul in the Guard Room, where the Mediterranean Pass will be communicated to them.
8. The active Officers of the Provincial Priory of Malta will be invested along with those receiving Promotions and First Appointments.
9. A representative candidate of the Knights will be admitted and Installed into the Order of Malta along with elected Knights by the Provincial Sub-Prior.
10. Alms will be collected during which the Malta hymn shall be sung.
11. Any other business for the good of the Order or for the Province of London will be considered.
12. The Provincial Prior will announce the date and place of the next meeting and will call for a Priory to act as the Host Priory.
13. A Chapter of Provincial Priory of Malta will be closed.
14. The first verse of the National Anthem will be sung.
15. The Provincial Prior will retire in procession accompanied by the Great Officers.
16. The Provincial Sub-Prior will retire in procession with the Provincial Prelate and Officers of the Pentagonal and Octagonal Tables.
17. The Temple Delegation will retire in procession.

Report of the Proceedings of the Chapter of Provincial Priory of Malta held under the Banner of New Temple No. 117, on Monday 30th January 2023.

At 4.15pm the Knights were assembled in the Temple. The first procession was led V. E. Kt. Keith Florence followed by the Temple Delegation, who all entered under an Arch of Steel. At 4.20pm, the Provincial Sub-Prior, E. Kt. Antony Fabian Legge, accompanied by the Provincial Prelate and Officers of the Octagonal and Pentagonal Tables entered in procession and took their seats. This was followed by the entry of the Provincial Prior, Rt. E. Kt. David James Thompson who was accompanied by Rt. E. Kt. Edwin Goodwin K.C.T. and V. E. Kts. Richard Fogwill and Leslie Fox.

At 4.35pm, the Provincial Priory was opened by the Rt. E. Provincial Sub-Prior, Antony Fabian Legge in due form and the minutes of the previous Malta Meeting from January 2022 were confirmed. At 4.40pm 15 candidates were elected as Knights of Malta and V. E. Kt. Richard Fogwill and the Provincial Prelate, Rev'd Niall Johnston left the Temple. The candidates were then admitted as Knights of St. Paul in the Guard Room where the Mediterranean Pass was communicated to them.

During their absence, the Officers of the Provincial Priory of Malta were appointed and re-appointed by the Rt. E. Provincial Prior into their respective offices. Those receiving Past Provincial Ranks on promotion or on First Appointment were received.

The candidates were admitted back into the Temple, with Kt. Kevin Bayford being admitted at 5.00pm as the 'lead candidate'. The ceremony for all candidates was conducted by the Provincial Sub-Prior with the accolade given to each in turn by the Great Sub-Prior of Malta.

Alms were collected during the singing of the Malta Hymn. During 'Any Other Business' a Service Medal of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem was presented by E. Kt. Jamie Ingham Clark to E. Kt. Vernon King for his service.

The next Malta meeting was announced that it would be held on Monday 29th January 2024, and under the banner of Coromandel Priory No. 73. The London Provincial Priory of Malta was closed in due form by the Eminent Provincial Sub-Prior at 5.45pm. The first verse of the National Anthem was sung and the Rt. E. Provincial Prior retired in procession. The E. Provincial Sub-Prior then retired with the Provincial Prelate and the Officers of the Pentagonal and Octagonal Tables followed by the final recession by the Temple Delegation.
