All Knights of the Province other than the 2020/21 Provincial Officers will be seated in the Temple by 4.15 p.m.

1. At 4.15 p.m. the Malta Delegation will enter.
2. The visiting Provincial Priors will enter.
3. The Knights Grand Cross and Knights Commander of the Temple will enter.
4. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior and Eminent Provincial Sub-Prior attended by Officers of the Province will enter.
5. A Chapter of Provincial Priory will be opened.
6. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will be saluted under the direction of the Provincial Marshal.
7. To honour the memory of Knights who have passed to the Holy City.
8. The minutes of the Provincial Business Meeting held on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021 will be submitted for confirmation.
9. The visiting Knights will be welcomed by the Right Eminent Provincial Prior, and saluted under the direction of the Provincial Marshal.
10. The Provincial Registrar will call the Muster Roll of the Provincial Officers.
11. The Preceptory Banners will be paraded and the Roll of Preceptories will be called.
12. The Provincial Treasurer will present his report.
13. To elect for the year 2021/2, (i) the Provincial Treasurer, E. Kt. Matthew Hampson, Past Great Herald, having been nominated as Treasurer, the Right Eminent Provincial Prior will declare the election in favor of the nominated Knight, provided no other member has indicated that he wished to be considered and no member present calls for a ballot (ii) Provincial Examiners of the Accounts and (iii) Four Knights to serve on the Provincial Council.

## **Minutes of the Provincial Priory of London Meeting 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021**

*Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the meeting was held over the internet via Zoom webinar.*

At 5pm the Provincial Prior, R.E.Kt. David James Thompson, welcomed everyone to the meeting and declared it open.

The Provincial Vice-Chancellor read the letter of permission and the dispensation to hold the Virtual Business Meeting.

A requiem was conducted by the Provincial Prelate in memory of the sixteen Knights of the Province who had passed to the Holy City during the previous year.

The minutes of the Chapter of Provincial Priory held on the Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019, having been circulated, were adopted by the Knights of the Province.

An election was held for the Office of Treasurer for the ensuing year. E.Kt. Matthew Hampson, Past Great Sword Bearer, having been nominated as Treasurer and as no other member wished to be considered and no member called for a ballot, the Provincial Prior declared the election in his favour.

E. Kts. Gavin O'Sullivan and Stephen Gill, having been nominated as examiners of the accounts for the ensuing year and as no other member wished to be considered and no member called for a ballot, the Provincial Prior declared the election in their favour.

E. Kts. John Bond, Colin Pope, James Fletcher and Major Dennis Bradley, having been nominated to serve on the Provincial Council for the ensuing year and as no other member wished to be considered and no member called for a ballot, the Provincial Prior declared the election in their favour.

The Provincial Treasurer presented his report on the finances of the Province for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020 and confirmed that the accounts showed that the finances of the Province to be in a healthy position. It was proposed and seconded that the accounts, having been previously circulated, be adopted with an expression of thanks both to the Treasurer and to the examiners of accounts. The proposition was carried

It was proposed that the Province donate £300 to St Botolph-without-Bishopsgate and £1,000 to the St. John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group, both from the Charity Account. The proposition was carried.

The Provincial Prior reported that due to the hard work of a number of Knights that a further £16,000 had been raised by the Province and donated to the St. John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group during the previous year.

The Provincial Prior briefly addressed the assembled Knights.

E. Kt. Ian Drury, Commander of the Provincial Prior's Body Guard, delivered an illustrated lecture: "The Teutonic Knights and the Northern Crusades." this was recorded and was uploaded on to the Provincial YouTube channel immediately after the meeting.

The Provincial Prior, R. E. Kt. David James Thompson, thanked E. Kt. Ian Drury for his interesting lecture and declared the meeting closed at 5:36pm.
