A SHOPPING LIST for

It is useful to understand exactly what costs are involved. There are obviously large ticket items that are needed relating to specific new equipment and projects, but there are also items and procedures that are carried out that fall within the remit of an individual or a Preceptory. Below are a few examples of simple procedural costs:

Unit cost (£)	Description
£7.00	An initial eye consultation
£25.00	Eye drops - typically used as the main treatment for conditions such as glaucoma)
£70.00	Diabetic related eye treatments
£250.00	Cataract treatment for one person
£250.00	Operation to correct a child's squint
£500.00	Urgent eye surgery

The next list focuses on items that can be funded at a range of prices and which include both recurring and non-recurring need. These are practical and are needed for the hospital to function efficiently and safely but are often less likely to be thought of than high value medical equipment.

It may be that the big-ticket items are outside the donations you have raised within your group or Preceptory. However, you can still purchase specific items that the Eye Hospital needs in order to continue to care effectively for it's patients across the Hospitals and Clinics within the Group.

£900	Drivers uniform (seasonally)	Continuously needed / Season
£1,000	3 x Fire Extinguishers	Continuously needed
£1,000	40 x Patients bed sheets	Continuously needed
£1,000	36 x Nurses uniforms	Continuously needed
£1,000	30 x Patients blankets	Continuously needed
£1,000	16 x Patients stools	Continuously needed
£1,000	4 x Waiting Room chair sets	Continuously needed
£1,000	8 x Doctor's office chairs	Continuously needed
£1,100	Guard's uniform (seasonally)	Continuously needed / Season
£1,550	Kitchen workers uniform (seasonally)	Continuously needed
£1,600	Cleaner's uniforms	Continuously needed / Season
£2,300	Patient's food trolley	Required by JCI and MoH
£2,800	Kitchen door	Replacement needed
£3,000	Cleaning supplies – monthly	Continuously needed
